



## **FRIENDS OF HOYT PARK & POOL 2023 THE LANDING AT HOYT PARK JOB DESCRIPTION**

Seasonal part-time employment from May 1, 2023 – October 29, 2023. Hours include evenings, weekends and holidays. Hourly wage rate to reflect areas of responsibility, knowledge, skills, training and experience. 2023 wage rates start at \$11 an hour.

Landing Crew employees welcome beer garden patrons, serve food and beverages and maintain a clean and orderly facility reflecting the high standards of the organization, and interact with the public using a positive attitude.

This position reports to the Operations Manager or Beer Garden Supervisors.

### **Specific Duties:**

1. Welcome beer garden patrons.
2. Prepare and serve beverage and food items quickly and efficiently.
3. Clear and clean tables and beer garden serving area.
4. Ensure patrons are of legal age to purchase adult beverage items.
5. Monitor and enforce beer garden and organization policies.
6. Perform cash handling functions at The Landing at Hoyt Park using touchscreen and keyboard equipment.
7. Perform other concessions work including operating food service equipment and preparing and serving food.
8. Perform manual tasks including routine cleaning and other duties as assigned.
9. Maintain a clean and neat appearance.
10. Maintain timely attendance.

### **Required Skills & Experience:**

1. Applicants must be 18 years of age by the date of employment.
2. 3 months experience in retail, food service, customer service or other related volunteer or community service.
3. Other combinations of training and/or experience which can be demonstrated to result in the possession of the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to perform the duties of these positions will also be considered.
4. Ability to provide excellent customer service to and communicate effectively with all patrons.

Additional position responsibilities in cash handling, employee scheduling, data processing (Microsoft Excel), supervisory responsibilities, and other responsibilities as assigned by management considered for wage rate.

**Work Schedule:** The Landing Beer Garden operates from May 1st to the end of October. The Landing Operations Manager schedules assignments to cover each day of the week. Landing beer garden schedules will include, 6 to 9 hour shifts covering 4 to 5 days per week. Scheduling can be flexible given proper notice of needed time off.

**Physical Demands:** The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

1. The employee is regularly required to talk and hear.
2. The employee frequently is required to stand; walk; bend; squat; use hands to finger, handle or feel; and reach with hands and arms.
3. This position requires the ability to occasionally lift supplies and equipment, up to 25 pounds.
